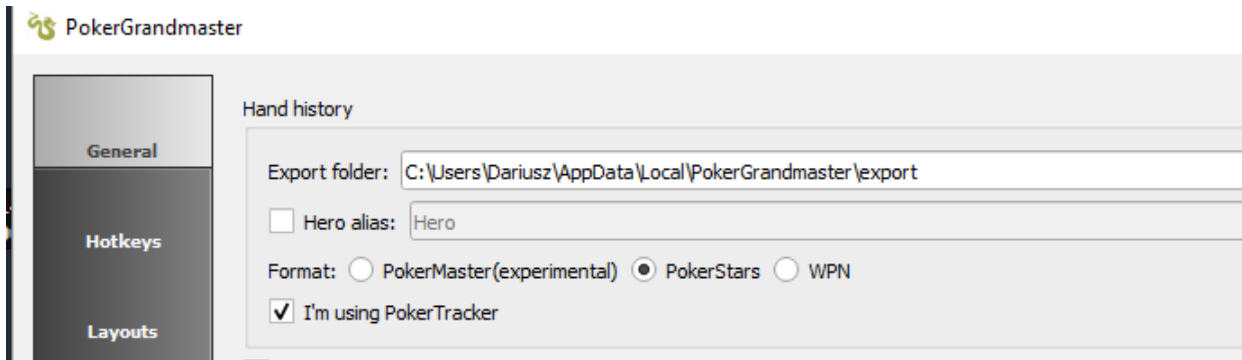
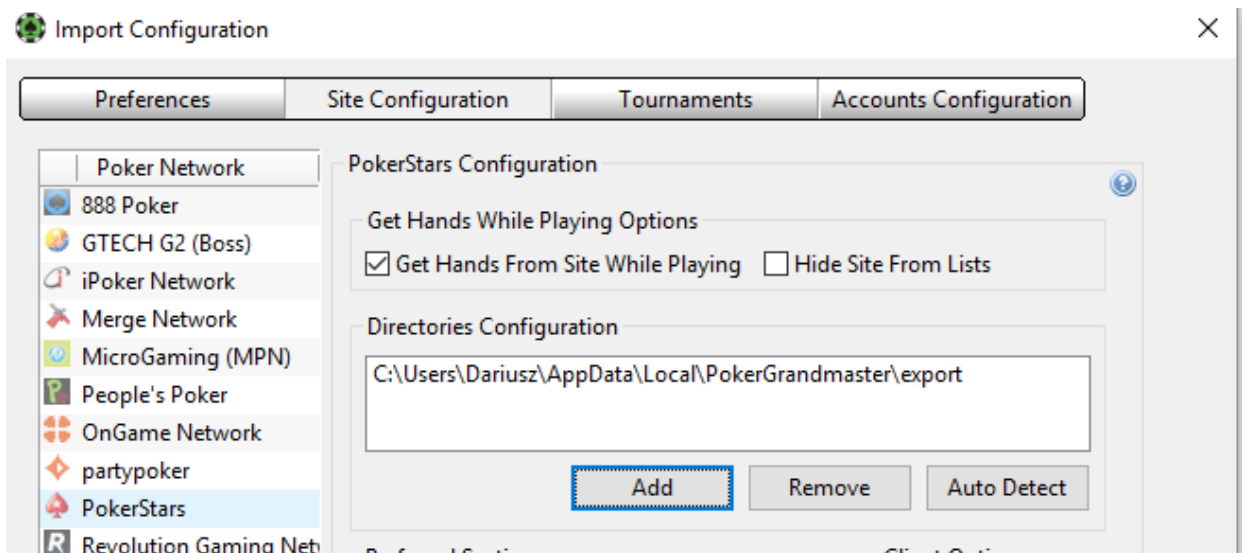


# Using PokerGrandmaster converter with PT4

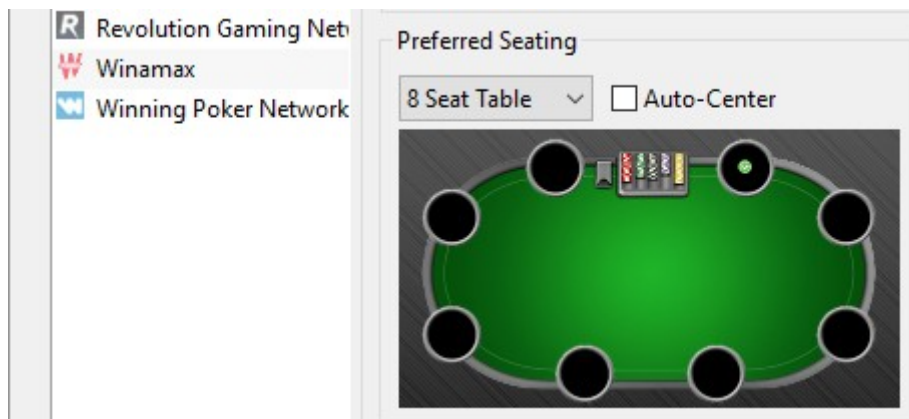
1. Go to PokerGrandmaster General tab and:
  - a) Set hand history format to PokerStars.
  - b) Enable "I'm using PokerTracker".
  - c) Take a look at hand history export folder.



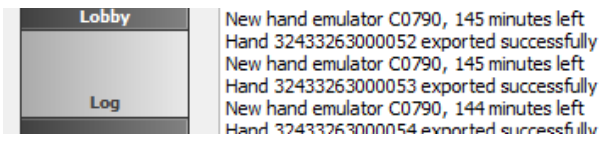
2. In PT4 go to Configure/Site Configuration/PokerStars and add PokerGrandmaster hand history export folder.



3. Disable Auto-Center and set preferred seat to 1 for all relevant table sizes.



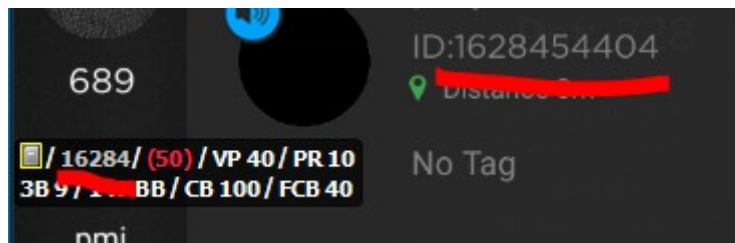
4. Observe a PokerMaster table and make sure that:
  - a) hands are being exported by PokerGrandmaster



- b) table is detected by PT4

5. Position the HUD for each player using PokerMaster player ID.



# Connecting PokerGrandmaster virtual lobby to PT4 database

1. Click on “Players List Settings” button in PokerGrandmaster Lobby tab.
2. Set all options except “Name” like on this picture:

3. Go to PT4/Database Management to find out what is you database name and set it in the “Name” field.
